IMPORTANT CURBSIDE RECYCLING INFORMATION

All material must be at curbside by 7:00 a.m.

COMMINGLED MATERIAL

- **METAL** cans should only consist of food and pet food types. Labels may remain on and metal lids included.
- **GLASS** jars and bottles of all types and colors are acceptable. Labels may remain on and metal caps included. Plastic caps should not be included.
- **PLASTIC** bottles such as soda, juice milk jugs and detergent containers that are coded with numbers 1 through 7; plastic caps should not be included.
- **EMPTY AEROSOL CANS** spray nozzle and plastic cap should not be included.
- **CLEAN ALUMINUM FOIL & TRAYS**
All commingled items must be rinsed to free them of food particles and residue. All material above should be combined together at curbside in a container/box that will be emptied and left for reuse.

Material in plastic bags will not be collected.

PAPER/CARDBOARD PULP

- **NEWSPAPER**, including inserts. May be bundled or placed in a container or box that can be emptied and left for reuse.
- **CARDBOARD** must be "non wax" cardboard and free of excessive amounts of plastic adhesive tape. Staples need not be removed. It can either be broken up and placed inside a container/cardboard box or used to contain newspaper.
- **BROWN GROCERY BAGS** should be folded and placed inside of another kraft bag or bag may be used to contain newspaper and junk mail.
- **MAGAZINES** consisting of colored, glossy periodicals and catalogs.
- **JUNK MAIL** consisting of envelopes, sweepstakes forms and office papers.

LARGE METAL ITEMS

LARGE HOUSEHOLD APPLIANCES, INCLUDING STOVES, REFRIGERATORS, AIR-CONDITIONERS, WASHER/DRYERS, BAR-BE-QUE GRILLS, SOFA-BEDS, EXERCISE EQUIPMENT ARE COLLECTED BY APPOINTMENT ONLY. PLEASE CALL DPW OFFICES AT 993-1576 TO SCHEDULE PICKUP OF THESE AND SIMILAR ITEMS.

ELECTRONIC WASTE DISPOSAL

TVs, COMPUTERS, RADIOS, PRINTERS, AND MOST OTHER SMALL APPLIANCES SUCH AS TOASTERS, COFFEE MAKERS, AND OLD PHONES ARE NO LONGER COLLECTED BY THE SANITATION DEPARTMENT. THESE DEVICES ARE ACCEPTED AT THE DPW YARD, 100 SPRAIN ROAD, ARDSLEY FROM 7:00 AM TO 3:00 PM, M-F.

YARD WASTE IN PLASTIC BAGS IS PROHIBITED

YARD WASTE BRANCHES/BRUSH (CUT TO 4' LENGTHS & TIED), LEAVES, GRASS, CLIPPINGS PLACED IN BIODEGRADABLE PAPER BAGS OR CONTAINED IN PAILS, BEGINS ON WEDNESDAY AND CONTINUES THROUGH FRIDAY.

YARD WASTE COLLECTION INFORMATION

Mulch! Mulch! Mulch! The Town encourages mulching grass clippings and leaves - "Love 'Em and Leave 'Em". See www.Irvingtonny.gov for more information about the benefits of mulching.

Collection of organic yard waste including tree debris is limited as follows:

- Grass clippings and other organic yard waste must be placed in biodegradable paper bags or open containers with weight not exceeding 50 pounds. No Plastic bags. Pickup occurs Wednesday through Friday.
- Tree debris must be tied and bundled into lengths not more than four feet and width not more than two feet, or placed in an open container.
- The Town does not collect debris from tree removals.

FALL LEAF COLLECTION

The Town encourages mulching of leaves. Bagged leaves will be collected weekly during the fall leaf collection program. Leaves may also be placed in piles adjacent to the street between October 15 and December 15 only. However, collection of leaf piles is limited and variable.

Leaf pile collection may be discontinued in 2012 - bagging may be required. Monitor Town Board actions for further information.

ORGANIC YARD WASTE DISPOSAL PERMITS

Landscapers may purchase permits to dispose Yard Organics at the Taxter Road organic yard waste transfer facility. Please call DPW Office at (914) 993-1576 or www.greenburghny.com for more information.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING E-WASTE

- County regulations require mandatory recycling of all e-waste. Anything with an electrical cord is considered e-waste.
- Items for e-waste recycling can be brought to the Highway Garage (100 Sprain Road, Ardsley) weekdays from 7am to 3pm.
- Local retailers may accept e-waste regardless of the origin of purchase. Please check county website or call a Retailer directly for further information.

WESTCHESTER COUNTY 2012 HOUSEHOLD CLEANUP DAYS

In 2012 Westchester County will be opening a facility in Valhalla to provide residents with a year-round drop-off point for items worthy of special handling including household chemicals, florescent bulbs, TVs, electronics, tires and more. The facility will be called the Household Materials Recovery Facility or H-MRF.

Frequently Asked Questions

- **How do I dispose of paint cans?** All paint must be either dried up using cat litter, or remaining paint can be poured onto rags to dry up; cans can be put out with trash but leave lids off.
- **How do I dispose of propane tanks?** Propane tanks should be disposed of during Westchester County Household Chemical Cleanup Days.
- **How do I dispose of construction debris?** Construction debris (including cement must be removed by a private carter or the contractor that did the work).
- **How do I dispose of Styrofoam - is it recyclable?** Styrofoam can be placed out with garbage.
- **How do I dispose of batteries - both household and car?** Regular batteries can be put out with the household garbage. Car batteries must be taken to a mechanic/gas station.
- **How do I dispose of carpet?** Carpeting must be cut into 4' lengths, tied up, then placed out with the garbage.
- **How do I dispose of medical needles?** These items must be placed in a leak, shatter and puncture-proof container with a screw top; label "Sharps" and put out with regular garbage. For further information on disposal of medical waste, please refer to the County of Westchester website.
- **Can I recycle all plastic containers?** Plastics numbered 1 to 7 can be recycled.
- **Are cereal boxes recyclable?** All types of cardboard containers, including cereal boxes, food containers, shoeboxes and gift boxes are recyclable.
