The Greenburgh Town Board voted 3-2 to ask the Commissioner of Planning to prepare a proposed rezone of Frank's nursery for recreational purposes. Once the Commissioner prepares his proposal to allow indoor recreation at Frank's (and other recreation uses) the Town Board will review the recommended rezone. Before any rezone takes place there will be an opportunity for the public to comment. The Town Board previously announced an auction for the property on December 3rd. The minimum asking price: \$3.5 million. Current permitted uses include residential, assisted living. The discussion and comments from Town Board members can be watched on the town website ([www.greenburghny.com-Town](http://www.greenburghny.com-Town) Board work session archives October 8 work session). We also discussed with our auditors their internal control report and recommendations re: Town Court. That discussion can also be watched on your computer. We expect to conduct an intensive internal audit of a different department of town government annually. These audits will help the town manage your taxes as efficiently as possible and to tighten up controls.
