INCIDENT: Arrest for Leaving the Scene of a Personal Injury Auto Accident.

On Sunday September 15, 2019 at 11:07 P.M. Officers on patrol came upon a pedestrian who had just been struck by a motor vehicle on Old Kensico Road where it intersects with Randolph Road. The victim a 23 year old male resident of Old Kensico Road had been dropped off by a friend and was crossing Old Kensico Road behind the friends vehicle when a Dark Colored vehicle traveling southbound on Old Kensico Road struck the victim propelling him into an adjacent driveway. The vehicle that struck him stopped momentarily and then fled the accident scene southbound on Old Kensico Road. The victim sustained head injuries and was transported by Greenburgh EMS to the Westchester County Medical Center where he was admitted.

On Monday November 18, 2019 after a lengthy investigation conducted by Greenburgh Detectives a 17 Year Old male who resides in the City of White Plains has been arrested and charged with Leaving the Scene of an Accident without Reporting where Personal Injury Occurred in Violation of Section 600 2AC of the Vehicle and Traffic Law, a Class E-Felony. The arrest stems from Detectives reviewing video footage from multiple locations along the route the vehicle traveled after striking the victim. This led them to identifying the vehicle to be a 2012 Honda Civic and subsequently to the 17 Year Old operator.

Pursuant to the Raise the Age Legislation effective October 1st 2019 he was issued an Appearance ticket and R.O.R. to his parents with a return date of November 21, 2019 to the Youth Part of County Supreme Court.
