### **Police Headquarters Facility Access**

Please be advised that due to the potential spread of COVID-19 (Coronavirus), and to ensure the safety of the community we serve as well as police officers, the Town of Greenburgh Police Department is implementing a policy of “limited public access” to Police Headquarters effective 7:00 P.M. this evening, Tuesday, March 17<sup>th</sup> 2020. This policy of limited public access shall be in effect until further notice.

Members of the public are asked to conduct non-emergency matters via telephone by calling (914) 989-1700. If you need immediate emergency assistance please call 9-1-1. You may file a police report for non-emergency matters using the on-line application which can be downloaded from our website at: [www.police.greenburghny.com](http://www.police.greenburghny.com). You may email the report to the Greenburgh Police Department at: [policereport@greenburghny.com](mailto:policereport@greenburghny.com). A Police Officer will call you to conduct a follow up interview via telephone.

Please note that copies of records or police reports, accident reports, may be requested by calling the Records Unit, Monday – Friday, between 9:00 A.M – 5:00 P.M. at (914) 989-1780. Fees for copies of records are waived until further notice. Persons requesting records shall provide (2) forms of identification via email to the records clerk and advise the nature of their request. It is our intention to render efficient police service to the public we serve while mitigating the potential threat of COVID 19 spread in our community.
