TDYCC Facility Guidelines (Covid-19)

- Observers are not permitted in the TDYCC facility. Only parent/guardian who need to assist their child get dressed and or check-in for a specific reason will be permitted entrance. They will then be required to leave the facility.
- A facial covering (mask) must be worn by everyone entering the facility and all participants and program staff while inside this facility unless directed otherwise by a program leader.
- Everyone entering the TDYCC facility (youth and adults), will have their temperature taken with a digital thermometer. If an individual has a recorded temperature of 100 or higher and expresses at least one symptom, we must report it to the County Department of Health within 24 hours. If a person returns a second day with a high temperature, they will not be allowed entry into the facility until the temperature returns to normal for at least two straight days.
- Currently, all adults are required to fill out a questionnaire every time they enter the TDYCC facility. Youth participants are not required to fill out this form.
- According to the current CDC guidelines, there will be no groups larger than fifteen (15) people allowed in a space smaller than 20ft x 30ft. This number can decrease in a smaller size space and expand in a larger space at the guidance of the Commissioner's office.
- According to the current CDC guidelines and state health department regarding quarantine, a participant who tests positive for Covid-19 will be reported to the county health department and ordered to quarantine for a period of 14 days. Any additional known participant(s) to have come in direct contact with the infected individual will also be advised to self-quarantine. We have certified contact tracers in place and on site. The infected participant cannot return until a medical professional has given clearance and documentation has been provided to our administration. In the event of a confirmed case, the entire facility will be shut down for a 24-hour period. During this time, we will have our maintenance team and or outside contractor come in and utilize electrostatic disinfectant technology which kills Coronavirus on contact.
- There will be no in-person Senior programming taking place within the TDYCC facility until further notice. There are a host of virtual programs currently running and still available. Our Senior Nutrition program, which can deliver a health meal to you five days a week, is available for those 60 years of age and older.
