Incident: Criminal Mischief to “Black Lives Matter” Sign; Possible Bias/Hate Incident

This agency is actively investigating the criminal mischief of a newly town-installed Black Lives Matter sign. During the overnight hours of May 13, 2021 the sign reading “All Lives Can’t Matter until Black Lives Matter” was uprooted from the ground, Just hours after it was affixed to the “Welcome to Greenburgh” sign located in the area of 1150 Knollwood Road.

The Town of Greenburgh and this department strongly condemns all acts of hate and bias. We have a history of promoting diversity, unity and inclusion. We are working with the Westchester County District Attorney’s Office to identify the individual(s) responsible for this incident and bring them to justice.
